CONCEPT NOTE















Collaborative Intelligence is a practice wherein crossfunctional teams across or within organizations share data and intelligence to create an infrastructure and systems layer on which future innovation can happen.

Collaborative: Multiple partners or teams coming working together towards a common objective.

Intelligence: Quantitative or qualitative intelligence that enables future innovation with regard to the shared common objective.
